Local Chapter Ordinances

Ordinance 1: Title

- Sec. 1. This chapter shall be known as Delta Theta Chapter, hereinafter referred to as the Chapter, of Kappa Psi Pharmaceutical Fraternity, Incorporated, according to the Charter granted by Alpha Chapter of Kappa Psi Pharmaceutical Fraternity, Incorporated, hereinafter referred to as the Fraternity, under the date of March 25, 1973.
- Sec. 2. No additions to By-Law I, Sec 2.

Ordinance 2: Membership

Sec. 1. A member in good standing in the Delta Theta Chapter of Kappa Psi is def ined as: having all dues paid as indicated in Ordinance 11, having attended ¾ of c hapter meetings and processes, having attended at least one event in each of the th ree following types of activities (professional, social, fundraising/community serv ice) each semester as documented and recorded by the respective Vice-Regent. Fi nes assessed for not completing these requirements follow these guidelines: Any Member not completing one event in each of the three types of activities above will be charged \$15 at the end of the semester. Any member who does not complete his or her obligations and fails to pay the fine at the end of the semester will be put on probation until the fine is paid; with the exception of APPE Brothers whom will only be required to pay Chapter dues. Any Member who believes that they have been unjustly fined may appeal, in writing, addressed to the Regent, Vice-Regen ts, Treasurer and Sergeant-at-Arms within 10 days after receiving notification of the fine. The appeal must be approved by unanimous vote by the above officers within 10 days.

Ordinance 3: Election of Members

Sec. 1. Prospective Members must meet the university requirements, attend the Chapter's interest meeting and complete the interview process. The prospective member sh all require an affirmative vote from at least three-fourths (3/4) of the Membership present at the time of interview to participate in the intake process. A prospective member will be removed from the intake process if he/she misses more than two (2) intake sessions. In the event that a Prospective Member fails to meet the intake expectations outlined by the Pledge Team, a vote may be called to remove him/he r by a brother that has attended at least two-thirds (2/3) of the sessions to date of t he vote. A three-fourths (3/4) vote must be obtained by Chapter Brothers present a t the time of discussion. A make-up session may be provided at the discretion of t he Pledge team.

Sec. 2. The eligibility of an active Member to participate in the pledge training period is a s follows: (1) any member wishing to be a "Big" must have a zero balance and be in good standing and (2) Brothers not in good standing will not be allowed to participate in pledging until all outstanding fines (dues, penalties, fines, etc.) have been paid.

Ordinance 4: Officers and Order of Election

Sec. 1. The Officers of the Chapter and Order of Election shall be: Regent, Co-Vice Reg ents (2), Secretary, Treasurer, Co-Historians (2), Co-Chaplains (2), Sergeant-at-A rms, Pledge Master, Co-Pledge Trainers (2), Webmaster and Grand Council Deputy.

Ordinance 5: Qualification, Election and Installation of Officers

- Sec. 1. A Brother must maintain a minimum of a 2.25 grade point average in order to ho ld these positions. Only Active members shall be considered for nomination to of fice. Investigation of all nominees to determine standing shall be performed prior to voting and the status of all nominees will be made known to the Chapter prior to voting.

- Sec. 3. The Secretary shall record the minutes at all general meetings of the Chapter and distribute the minutes of each meeting out to all members via electronic mail. The secretary shall keep all records of fines levied by the Sergeant-at-Arms on file for the duration of the Member's active status.

- Sec. 15. The Pledge Trainers shall be responsible for working closely with the Pledge Mas ter to plan, prepare, and execute the pledge process. They shall also possess a thor ough knowledge of the prospective member obligations as indicated in By-law III of the Uniform Collegiate Chapter By-Laws, Ordinance 3, Sec. 1., Fraternity and Chapter Risk Management Policy, and the Grand Council's Official Policy on Ha zing.
- Sec. 16. The Webmaster shall be responsible for updating the Chapter website at least onc e a month and shall be responsible for maintaining the Chapter and alumni e-mail listsery.

- Sec. 2. Each member shall pay the Treasurer of the Chapter dues of sixty dollars (\$60) p er semester for every year after their first year of membership. Brothers on APPE rotations with proper proof of membership in a graduate Chapter shall only pay fo rty dollars (\$40) per semester.
