BY-LAW XVII - LOCAL CHAPTER ORDINANCES**

ORDINANCE 1 – Title:

Section 1. This Chapter shall be known as Middle Tennessee Graduate Chapter, hereinafter referred to as the Chapter, according to the Charter granted by Alpha Chapter of Kappa Psi Pharmaceutical Fraternity, Incorporated, hereinafter referred to as the Fraternity, under the date of July 15th, 2011.

The Secretary-Treasurer shall notify all Members when nominations and elections are to take place at least fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting.
