Kappa Psi Pharmaceutical Fraternity, Inc. Montana Graduate Chapter By-Law XVII Local Chapter Ordinances

Ordinance 1: Title

Sec. 1. This Chapter shall be known as Montana Graduate Chapter, hereinafter referred to as the Chapter, of Kappa Psi Pharmaceutical Fraternity, Incorporated, according to the Charter granted by Alpha Chapter of Kappa Psi Pharmaceutical Fraternity, Incorporated, hereinafter referred to as the Fraternity, under the date of May 18th, 1997.

Sec. 1. The Officers of the Chapter and Order of Election shall be: Regent, Vice Regent, Secretary-Treasurer, Chaplain, Historian, Social/Project Coordinator, Scholarship Chairperson and GCC Chapter Delegate.

Ordinance 5: Qualification, Election and Installation of Officers

Sec. 1. Nominations of Officers will occur at the meeting prior to the elections or in writing to the current Regent of the Chapter within one week prior to elections. An announcement concerning the call for nominations will go out at least fourteen (14) days from the time that the nominations are to take place. Officers shall hold office for a two year period. Elections shall take place at the second meeting of the calendar year.

Sec. 2. The Regent may, at his discretion, allow for mail based voting in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised (10th Edition) provided no more than two (2) candidates are standing for election to the same office to prevent need for run-off elections in situations where the secret ballot cannot be maintained due to utilization of a teleconference meeting.

The election meeting shall be scheduled at such a place where the installation of officers may take place according to the Ritual, privately, without compromising the secrecy of the Ritual.

Ordinance 6: Duties of Officers

- Sec. 1. The Regent shall attend all Chapter functions as well as as many Collegiate and Fraternity events as possible. The Regent is also responsible for notifying all graduating Collegiate Members as well as any interested Graduate Members by letter to inform them of the purpose, activities and responsibilities of the Chapter, and to invite them to become members. The Regent will also arrange the times and agenda and lead the meetings of the Chapter.
- Sec. 2. The Vice Regent is responsible for the production and distribution of the semiannual newsletter of the Chapter. The Vice Regent will also assume the duties of the Regent as needed.
- Sec. 3. The Secretary-Treasurer shall provide the Chapter with membership and financial information at all meetings and take and distribute minutes to the membership of all meetings. In addition, the Secretary-Treasurer will receive and distribute all communications to and from The Central Office, and will supply the Regent with the names, addresses and phone numbers of all the dues-paying members twice a year. The Secretary-Treasurer shall supply all pertinent information to the Regent within 48 hours of a meeting if unable to attend. Any and all information normally presented by the Secretary-Treasurer will be forwarded to the Regent.

- Sec. 11. The Social/Project Coordinator shall coordinate group social activities of the Chapter as well as plan Chapter Professional Projects. This can include activities and events surrounding the bi-annual meetings of the Chapter. Duties will consist of location, event and food

planning/arrangements as needed. This officer shall also assist the Regent and Secretary/Treasurer, when requested, with mailings and/or phone calls for upcoming meetings and events.

Sec. 12. The Scholarship Chairperson shall maintain a record of available scholarships and their criteria for eligibility; maintain a record of recipients of each scholarship within the Graduate and Collegiate Chapter; keep accurate record of monies available in all Chapter accounts used to fund scholarships; notify The Central Office and THE MASK of all winners of scholarships, maintain correspondence with the Office of Student Affairs in the School of Pharmacy on all matters pertaining to Kappa Psi Scholarships; obtain a list of all eligible Kappa Psi collegiate member's scholarships and awards selected by the School of Pharmacy's Scholarship Committee; notify eligible students of scholarships which are awarded by the Kappa Psi Scholarship Committee; acknowledge all recipients of scholarships/awards as described in each, and inform Graduate Members of the scholarship/award opportunities and recipients.

 - Sub-Sec. D. Members of the Scholarship Committee shall consist of the Executive Committee with the elected Scholarship Chairperson overseeing the Committee.
